Alice is a average Girl Scout who meets with a troop of eight other girls her age.

Their trained leader facilitates 90-minute meetings twice a month, but my, what happens in those 90 minutes! Alice participates in troop governance and votes on activities, helps lead a section of the meeting by sharing ideas, presents information to help earn badges, or she learns a new skill. She's developing social and cooperative skills, new interests, and lasting friendships.

During the year, Alice's troop will conduct community service projects to collect food or toys, plant flowers, help at an animal shelter, visit a nursing home, clean a park, or help at a food pantry. She may participate in an engineering program, ride horses, learn about careers, go white water rafting, or learn about other cultures. She's developing independent living skills, courage, confidence and team-building skills. The popular Girl Scout Cookie Program is the world's largest financial literacy and entrepreneurial program for girls with lessons in goal setting, developing a plan, customer service, marketing and budgeting. Through Girl Scouts, Alice is discovering who she is, honing her values, connecting with others and taking actions that make a difference.
